Educational Goals & Objectives:

- 1. To dedicate time and effort to creation and implementation of a structured study plan.

- 6. Deliverables may include chapter summaries to be shared with residents on Convo or a specific number of question bank questions completed. Other options may be possible and discussed with faculty mentor prior to start of selective.
- 7. If on AEP, meet with assigned study advisor and/or Allie Min to determine deliverables and scheduled meeting plan.

- 3. Verbal and written feedback as indicated.
